I have no comment on revising the format of your presentation. It seems to be pretty straightforward and easy to follow.

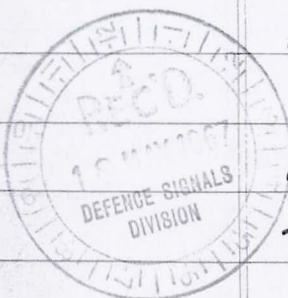
