EXTRACT FROM THE MINUTES OF THE MEETING OF THE
JOINT INTELLIGENCE COMMITTEE (S) HELD ON ... 11.5.1954.

ITEM 10 - MALAYAN COMMUNIST RECONNAISSANCE

10. Mr. Burrough informed the Committee that an Australian Army team had been operating in the Federation for some time with a view to finding and identifying Malayan Communist Party W/T activity and had not achieved any positive result. Consideration was now being given to withdrawing the party.

11. It was noted that the Director, [redacted] during his recent visit, had expressed the view that any Malayan Communist Party trans-
missions could be expected to have technical similarities with [redacted]. In view of Defence Signals Branch's experience on [redacted], he hoped the Australian authorities would consider accepting it as a task should traffic be found.
